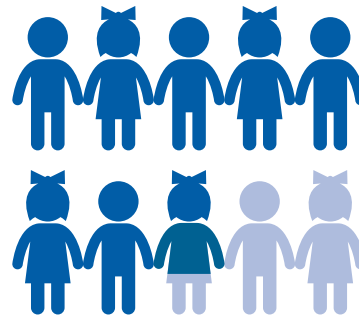

BEST PRACTICES



Test all children at ages 1 and again at
age 2; or up to age 6, if they have not
previously been tested.

Test pregnant and lactating women
when a single risk factor is present.

High-risk populations required to test:

- All Medicaid children at age 1 and age 2;
or up to age 6, if they have not previously
been tested.
- All children prior to Head Start enrollment.
