#### Who needs to be tested?

#### Universal

- Federal rules require blood lead testing of all Medicaid children at ages 1 and 2 years old, and 3 to 6 year olds if they have not been previously tested.
- Discuss lead exposure with all women who are planning a pregnancy, pregnant or lactating.
   CDC & ACOG recommendation testing when a single risk factor is identified.

#### **Targeted**

- Test according to <u>recommendations by the American Academy of Pediatrics (AAP)</u>
  - Verbal risk assessment should be used starting with the child's 6 month preventive health care visit to determine the child's risk to lead hazard exposures.
  - At ages 12 and 24 months of age, a blood lead test should be completed.
- Test children 6 to 72 months of age, and pregnant women, anytime a lead hazard risk is identified using the <u>lead poisoning verbal risk assessment</u>.
- Test children anytime at 25-72 months of age if they have not previously been tested.
