



Test pregnant and lactating women when a single risk factor is present.

### High-risk populations required to test:

- All Medicaid children at age 1 and age 2; or up to age 6, if they have not previously been tested.
- All children prior to Head Start enrollment.
- All children living in a high-risk zip code at 12 and 24 months, and up to age 6, if they have not been previously tested.
