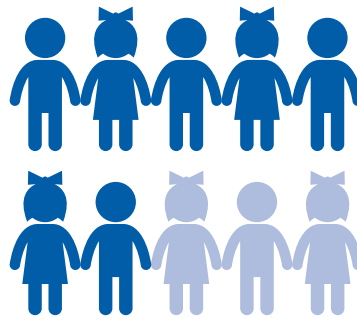

BEST PRACTICES



New York State Requirement:

Test all children at ages 1 and again at age 2; or up to age 6, if they have not previously been tested.

Assess all pregnant women for lead exposure using a risk assessment tool at the initial prenatal visit. Test when one risk factor is present.
