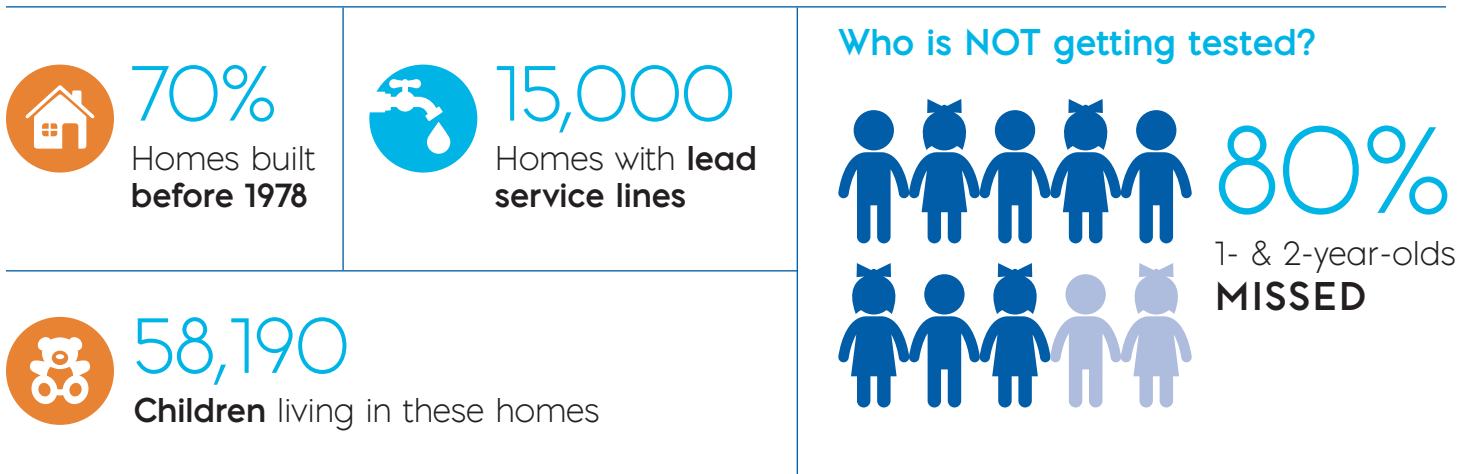
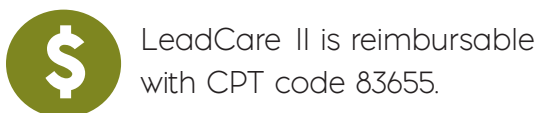

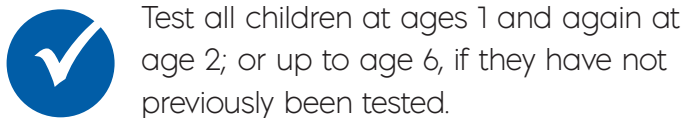

Test pregnant and lactating women when one risk factor is present.

Populations required to test:

- As of June 27, 2019, Maine law requires blood lead testing of all children at ages one and two years of age.
- Federal law requires blood lead testing of all children covered by MaineCare (Medicaid) at ages 1 and again at age 2; or up to age 6, if they have not previously been tested.
- All children prior to Head Start enrollment.
